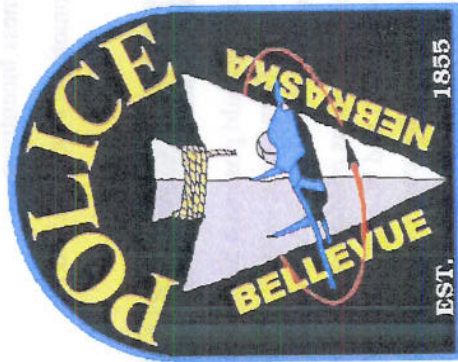


TESTING PROCEDURE

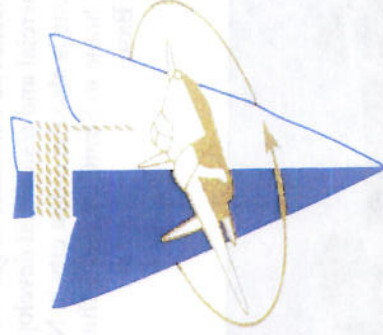
